Importance of High School Pipeline Programs for Healthcare

- Addressing Workforce Shortages
- Increasing Diversity in Healthcare: Pipeline programs targeting underrepresented minorities significantly increase diversity in healthcare professions.
- Improved Academic Performance and College Attendance: Participants in healthcare pipeline programs are more likely to pursue degrees in healthcare fields.
- Retention in Health Professions: Pipeline program participants have retention rates of 70-80% in healthcare fields.
- Community Impact: Pipeline programs often focus on underserved communities, increasing the likelihood that participants will serve those communities.


The Importance of Diversity in Healthcare Professions

- Improved Patient Outcomes: Patients treated by healthcare professionals of the same racial or ethnic background have better communication, are more satisfied with their care, and have better health outcomes.
- Cultural Competence: A diverse healthcare workforce can provide culturally competent care, leading to more effective treatment and greater patient trust.
- Reduction of Health Disparities: Increasing diversity in the healthcare workforce is key to reducing health disparities among underserved populations.
- Economic Benefits: A diverse and inclusive workforce is linked to better financial performance, including higher revenues and better innovation.
- Educational Environments: Diverse educational environments improve the cultural competence of all students, preparing them to serve diverse populations.

MASH Camp 2024 Accomplishments

- 213 Applicants from Pierce, North Thurston, South Kitsap, and South King Counties
- 78 Students Accepted (36% acceptance rate)
- 12 Active Participants in the Running Start program (15%)
- >95% Daily Excellence Rating by students for their camp experience
- Onboarded all participants as MultiCare volunteers


Hands-on activities, i.e., suturing, stapling, injections, mock codes, OR instruments simulation, escape room, etc.


