Guidelines for Air vs. Ground:

## Emergent Transfer:

- Hemodynamic instability
- · Emergent surgical/intervention needed
- Airway or respiratory instability
- Immediate threat to life

Transport distance:
Greater than 40 miles and/or 45 mins

#### **Urgent Transfer:**

- Hemodynamic stability
- Urgent surgical need
- Electrolyte/medication management
- Moderate respiratory support

Transport distance:

Greater than 70 miles and/or 1.5 hours

#### **Stable Transfer:**

- Hemodynamic and respiratory stability
- Ongoing observation
- Pediatric specialty consult

Transport distance: Greater than 80 miles and/or Central/Eastern WA

### **Pediatric Transport Team**

The Mary Bridge Pediatric Transport Team provides inter-facility transport services for all pediatric patients requiring specialized pediatric care. The team's mission is to provide stabilization, emergency, and critical care to ill and injured pediatric patients during interfacility transfers. Our partnership with Airlift Northwest allows our team to provide air (helicopter and fixed wing) transport in addition to ground transport.

#### **Transport Services Provided:**

- · Advanced airway management
- Invasive and non-invasive ventilation
- Vasoactive medication and infusion administration
- · Cardiopulmonary monitoring
- Trauma care
- Post-resuscitation care

#### **Team Highlights:**

- Transport Team consists of dedicated pediatric transport nurses and respiratory therapists with special training in caring for patients in an out-of-hospital environment.
- · Transport newborn to adolescents
- · Common diagnoses for transport:
  - o Respiratory illnesses (asthma, bronchiolitis, pneumonia)
  - o Sepsis
  - o Congenital heart defects and heart failure
  - o Trauma
  - o Appendicitis and other general surgical needs
  - o Seizures and other neurologic disorders
